


Dear Fellow Oklahoman,



## WHAT WE DO:

Oklahoma law requires the State Auditor's Office to provide objective and comprehensive evaluations of the practices and operations of state, county and local governments including agencies, boards, commissions and governmental offices dealing with public funds. We issue approximately 500 audit reports annually to show where Oklahoma tax dollars are being spent.

Our Office offers a variety of auditing positions with great benefits and opportunities for growth. As an equal opportunity employer we encourage all qualified applicants to apply.

## POSITIONS AVAILABLE:

### STATE AGENCY AUDIT SERVICES

A State Agency Auditor provides accountability of state government to its leaders, citizens and the federal government. They accomplish this by conducting financial audits, compliance audits, attestation engagements, performance audits, information system audits and other special audits.

### PERFORMANCE AUDIT SERVICES

A Performance Auditor works to ensure government agencies and entities are working in the most cost efficient manner possible. By auditing operations they are able to aid those responsible for initiating corrective action with the proper procedures.

### INVESTIGATIVE AUDIT SERVICES

The Investigative Auditor works to ensure fraud, embezzlement or any act of wrongdoing does not take place within a government body. They do this by assisting the Attorney General, district attorneys, citizens and governmental entities in the determination of compliance or noncompliance with state laws, local policies, proper accounting principles and good management practices.

### GAMING AND HORSE RACING AUDIT SERVICES

A Gaming Auditor is responsible for monitoring all gaming activities at Oklahoma racetracks. A Horse Racing Auditor is responsible for monitoring all wagering activities at racetracks and their off-track wagering facilities licensed by the Oklahoma Racing Commission.

### INFORMATION SYSTEMS AUDIT SERVICES

An ISAS Auditor is responsible for obtaining and documenting an understanding of the internal control structure in an agency's information system.

### COUNTY AUDIT SERVICES

A County Auditor is responsible for conducting financial and compliance audits in all 77 counties across the State as well as 51 Emergency Medical Service Districts. These audits include all functions of county government.
