

Background

The Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission (the Commission) was created to encourage, foster, and assist in the development of aeronautics in Oklahoma and to encourage the establishment and maintenance of public airports.

Oversight is provided by seven commission members. They are:

The City of Ardmore (the Sponsor) applied for assistance from the Commission to seal cracks as well as patch and overlay the runway at the Ardmore Downtown Executive Airport. The Commission committed \$487,895 to this \$700,000 project while the Sponsor pledged \$62,105. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) funded the difference.

Purpose and Scope

This audit was conducted in response to the Commission's request.

The audit period covered was June 8, 2006 through November 7, 2012.

We conducted this performance audit in accordance with generally accepted government auditing standards. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain sufficient, appropriate evidence to provide a reasonable basis for our findings and conclusions based on our audit objectives. We believe that the evidence obtained provides a reasonable basis for our findings and conclusions based on our audit objectives. This report is a public document pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records Act (51 O.S. § 24A.1 et seq.), and shall be open to any person for inspection and copying.

Objective - Determine whether expenditures paid to the City of Ardmore (state project number 1FO-06-SF) were in accordance with *Exhibit B-1 - Program Narrative* and *Exhibit B-2 - Project Costs* of the airport construction agreement.

Conclusion

The expenditures paid to the City of Ardmore were in accordance with *Exhibit B-1 - Program Narrative* and *Exhibit B-2 - Project Costs* of the airport construction agreement¹.

Methodology

To accomplish our objective, we performed the following:

- Reviewed the airport construction agreement;
- Interviewed the airport manager and the project engineer;
- Reviewed the bids submitted by construction contractors for the project;

¹ Although the expenditures paid to the Sponsor were in accordance with the specified portions of the contract, \$267,582 was considered ineligible costs by the FAA and the Commission and both entities sought reimbursement from the Sponsor. This matter is discussed further on pages 4 and 5 of this report.

- Reviewed all invoices submitted by the contractors to the engineer and Sponsor;
- Reviewed all requests for reimbursement submitted by the Sponsor;
- Documented the expenditure process related to the construction project;
 and
- Observed the completed project.

There were no exceptions noted as a result of these procedures.

APPENDIX

The following information has been presented at the request of management. Our objective was to determine whether expenditures paid to the City of Ardmore (state project number 1FO-06-SF) were in accordance with $Exhibit\ B-1-Program\ Narrative$ and $Exhibit\ B-2-Project\ Costs$ of the airport construction agreement. Therefore, we did not conclude on the following schedules and information.

^{*} The actual construction amount includes \$267,582 of disallowed expenses due to the contractor's use of a base course which was ineligible for funding. The FAA's share of this expense was \$57,339, OAC's share was \$186,503, and the Sponsor's share was \$23,740. According to unaudited Commission records, the Sponsor paid the Commission \$69,211 in May 2012 and still owes \$69,210 as of the date of this report. (\$186,503 - \$48,082 (previously not reimbursed by the Commission to the Sponsor) - \$69,211 = \$69,210)
