BUDGET MEMO

June 12, 2023

The 2023/2024 Annual Budget for the Town of Byron is presented, as attached, for approval by the Council. It includes the following highlights for the fiscal year:

- Sales tax has been budgeted at 90% of current year projections. If collected at 100% the town would receive an extra ~\$1,266 in income for FY24.
- * The budget does not include any utility rate increases from our customers. Consistent with prior years, the budget projects to break even in regards to our trash service.
- * No Capital Outlay Items are included in the budget.
- * This budget projects a net loss of <\$11,160> for Fiscal Year 2024. We currently have sufficient reserves to absorb the loss in the current year, if that is the Board's desire.

In accordance with Section 17-208, Title 11, Oklahoma Statutes, the fiscal year 2023/2024 budget was initially presented to Council on May 30, 2023 for consideration.

The legal level of control for the Town's 2023/2024 Budget is established at the Department level. Additional detail is provided for analysis purposes only.
