BUDGET MEMO

May 26, 2017 updated June 13, 2017

The 2017 / 2018 Annual Budget for the Town of Byron is presented, as attached, for approval by the Council. It includes the following highlights for the fiscal year:

Recurring tax revenues are budgeted at 90% of estimated FY17 collections, as indicated.

The budget does not include any utility rate increases from our customers. Consistent with prior years, the budget projects spending more to provide trash service than we collect in fees.

The budget includes one employee in General Government at 20 hours/week for 20 weeks of the year at \$15/hour. An estimated amount for the required employer taxes are included in the budget. The budget also includes the new pay rates for City Officials.

General Fund Capital Outlay budget includes an estimated \$15,000 to install electricity at the shed, construct a lean-to and replace ceiling tiles in City Hall.

The Street & Alley budget includes \$2,000 for the purchase of rock for maintenance.

In accordance with Section 17-208, Title 11, Oklahoma Statutes, the fiscal year 2017 / 2018 budget was initially presented to Council on May 26, 2017 for consideration.

The legal level of control for the Town's 2017 / 2018 budget is established at the Department level. Additional detail is provided for analysis purposes only.
