#### BUDGET MEMO

June 9, 2022

The 2022/2023 Budget for the Town of Beaver are presented, as attached, for approval by the Council in accordance with the Oklahoma Municipal Budget Act.

- Recurring tax revenues have been budgeted at 90% of current year projections. If collected at 100%, we'd receive an additional ~\$73,102 in tax revenues.
- The budget includes 5% rate increases for all utility services provided by the Town, generating an estimated \$46,500.
- The budget includes raises for all full-time employees, which will add ~\$6,273 in expenses. Retirement is budgeted to continue at the current Town contribution rate of 15%.

In accordance with Section 17-208, Title 11, Oklahoma Statutes, the fiscal year 2022/ 2023 budget was initially presented to Council on May 12, 2022 for consideration. A public hearing will be held for <a href="https://doi.org/10.2022/journal.org/">Thursday, June 9, 2022</a>.

The legal level of control for the City's 2022/2023 budget is established at the Department level. Additional detail is provided for analysis purposes only. Management may make transfers between departments throughout the year.

# A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TOWN OF BEAVER, OKLAHOMA BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 AND ESTABLISHING BUDGET AMENDMENT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, The Town of Beaver has adopted the provisions of the Oklahoma Municipal Budget Act (the Act) in 11 O.S. Sections 17-201 through 17-216; and

WHEREAS, The Chief Executive Officer has prepared a budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (FY 2022-2023) consistent with the Act; and

WHEREAS, The Act in section 17-215 provides for the chief executive officer of the Town, or designee, as authorized by the governing body, to transfer any unexpended and unencumbered appropriation from one department to another within the same fund; and

WHEREAS, The budget has been formally presented to the Town Board of Trustees at least 30 days prior to the start of the fiscal year in compliance with Section 17-205; and

WHEREAS, The Town Board of Trustees has conducted a Public Hearing at least 15 days prior to the start of the fiscal year, and published notice of the Public Hearing in compliance with Section 17-208 of the Act; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BEAVER, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The Town Board of Trustees does hereby adopt the FY 2022-2023 Budget on the 9th day of June 2022 with total resources available in the amount of \$4,735,381 and total fund/departmental appropriations in the amount of \$1,869,267. 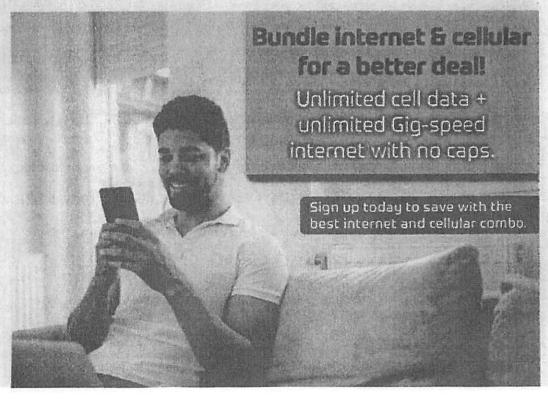
