

RESOLUTION 2024-1

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TOWN OF CARNEGIE, OKLAHOMA BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 AND ESTABLISHING BUDGET AMENDMENT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, The Town of Carnegie has adopted the provisions of the Oklahoma Municipal Budget Act (the Act) in 11 O.S. Section 17-201 through 17-218 by Resolution #2024-1; and

WHEREAS, The Town Clerk has prepared a budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (FY 2024-2025) consistent with the Act; and

WHEREAS, The Act in section 17-215 provides for the chief executive office of the Town, or designee, as authorized by the governing body, to transfer any unexpended and unencumbered appropriation from one object category to another within the same department of a fund; and

WHEREAS, The budget has been formally presented to the Carnegie Town Board of Trustees in compliance with Section 17-205; and

WHEREAS, The Carnegie Town Board of Trustees has conducted a Public Hearing at least 15 days prior to the start of the fiscal year in compliance with Section 17-208 of the Act; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CARNEGIE, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The Carnegie Town Council does hereby adopt the FY 2024-2025 Budget on the 28th of June 2024 with total resources available for all budgeted funds. Legal appropriations (spending/encumbering limits) are hereby established for Line Item by Department.

SECTION 2. The Carnegie Town Board of Trustees does hereby authorize the Town Clerk to transfer any unexpended and unencumbered appropriations, at any time throughout FY 2024-2025, from one-line item to another within the same fund, without further approval of the Town Board of Trustees.

SECTION 3. All supplemental appropriations or decrease in the total appropriations of a fund shall be adopted at a meeting of the Town Board of Trustees.


