- **SECTION 1.** The City Council does hereby adopt the FY 2017-18 Budget on the 25th day of May, 2017, as presented in the attached budget, with totals by department within each fund.
- **SECTION 2**. The City Council does hereby authorize the Mayor to transfer between departments within a fund and to make budgeted transfers between funds as presented in the attached budget.
- **SECTION 3**. This resolution and a copy of the adopted budget will be transmitted to the Oklahoma State Auditor and Inspector and one copy submitted to the Clerk/Treasurer of this municipality.

City of Wilson, Oklahoma Budget Message For the Year Ended June 30, 2018

On the following pages is the budget document for the City of Wilson, Oklahoma for the fiscal year 2017-18 as required by Oklahoma Statutes (O.S. Title 11, Secs. 17-201 through 17-216).

This document adequately provides the programs, services and capital expenditures determined to be necessary and beneficial by the City Council, and it provides for certain amounts of fund balances to be retained which would be available for cases of public emergency or would be carried forward to the next fiscal year, if not used.

The document is prepared in a format to show the following information about the revenues, expenditures, and fund balances of each of the City's operating funds:

- Actual Amounts for 2015-16
- Budgeted Amounts for 2016-17
- Actual Amounts through 4-30-2017
- Proposed Budget Amounts for 2017-18

This format is designed so that members of the council, staff and general public can readily see the past, present and expected future activities within each fund.

Under the budget process, the mayor and consultants prepare a preliminary version of the budget document which is then published. A recommended budget document is then brought before the City Council and a public hearing to enable the Council to receive additional information and feedback regarding the budget from the City's citizens. After such hearing, further changes may be made to the budget before its final adoption by the Council prior to the beginning of the 2017-2018 fiscal year.

The budget highlights for the 2017-2018 fiscal year include the following: C.O.L.A. pay raise; \$20,000 in dilapidated property abatement cleanup; insulating the PWA building; paving Idlewood Circle, Elm, and Dogwood; and playground equipment.

It is the intent and hope of the council that this process will allow for diligent, timely and responsible preparation of a fiscal budget document, which can best serve the needs of the City of Wilson and its citizens.
