- Verify that the Commissioner's equipment items on hand agree with inventory records as of December 28, 2006, maintained in compliance with 19 O.S. § 178.1 by the County Clerk.
- Verify that the amount of total claims approved for the operation of the Commissioner's office is not in excess of limitations imposed by 19 O.S. § 347.
- Verify that machinery and equipment acquisitions, dispositions, and expenditures to date are in accordance with 19 O.S. § 333.
- Verify that the Commissioner's consumable items on hand agree with consumable inventory records as of December 5, 2006, maintained in compliance with 19 O.S. § 1502.

All information included in the inventory records, appropriation ledgers, and the general ledger is the representation of the respective county officers.

Our officer turnover engagement was limited to the procedures performed above and was less in scope than an audit performed in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion on any general-purpose financial statements of Cleveland County.

Based on our procedures performed, equipment items on hand agreed with the County Clerk's inventory records maintained in compliance with 19 O.S. § 178.1; the amount of total claims approved did not exceed limitations imposed by 19 O.S. § 347; and machinery and equipment acquisitions, dispositions, and expenditures to date were in compliance with 19 O.S. § 333. With respect to consumable inventories, our finding is included in the schedule of findings and recommendations.

This report is intended for the information and use of the management of Cleveland County. However, this report is a matter of public record and its distribution is not limited.

Finding 2007-1 - Consumable Inventory Records

Criteria: Title 19 O.S. § 1502 prescribes the procedures to be used to account for supplies and materials used in the construction and maintenance of roads and bridges.

Condition: It was noted during our examination of consumable inventory items that variances existed between consumable inventory stock cards and physical counts. The variances are noted in Appendix A.

Recommendation: We recommend that the County Commissioner investigate the discrepancies between the consumable records and the physical inventory of consumable items and make appropriate adjustments. We also recommend that a physical inventory of consumable inventory items be periodically conducted to ensure the necessary accountability of inventories.

View of responsible officials and planned corrective actions: The newly elected County Commissioner is aware of these discrepancies and will investigate and update consumable inventory records.
