To the County Excise Board of said County and State, Greeting:-

Pursuant to the requirements of 68 O.S. Section 3002, we submit herewith for your consideration, the within statement of the fiscal condition of the Grove Emergency Medical Service District, County of Delaware, State of Oklahoma, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2016, together with an itemized statement of the estimated needs thereof for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016 and ending June 30, 2017. The same have been prepared in conformity to Statute, in relation to which be it further noted that:

- 1. We, the members of the Grove Emergency Medical Service District Board of said County and State, do hereby certify that the statements herein submitted show the true and correct conditions of the fiscal affairs of said Grove Emergency Medical Service District for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, that said statements comprise a "full and accurate statement of the assessments, receipts and expenditures of the preceding year, made out in detail under separate heads" as required by 19 O.S. Section 345; that said preparation was had at an official session of said Board, begun on the first Monday in July, 2016 pursuant to the provisions of 68 O.S. Section 3002.
- 2. And we further certify that the estimates of the several amounts necessary for current expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016 and ending June 30, 2017 as shown under "Schedule 8" were prepared and filed with the Grove Emergency Medical Service District as of the first Monday in July 2016, that the same have been correctly entered, and that all estimates made are entered as certified by Department Heads for the respective purposes herein set out. We further certify that the sums requested for salaries of county officers and the deputies are calculated and based upon authority of salary statutes currently effective and applicable in this county.
- 3. We further certify that the estimated income from sources other than ad valorem tax, shown on "Schedule 4", may reasonably be expected to be collected as a revenue during the ensuing fiscal year, and is not in excess of the 90% of the amounts collected for the same sources during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.
