We compiled the information presented in this report from the statistical data obtained from the gaming vendors and licensees located at Will Rogers Downs and Remington Park for the month of February 2010.

We were not engaged to perform an audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion on specified elements or accounts. This report relates only to the procedures specified above and does not extend to any financial statements of the racetracks or racinos taken as a whole.

Accordingly, we do not express an opinion on their internal control structure.

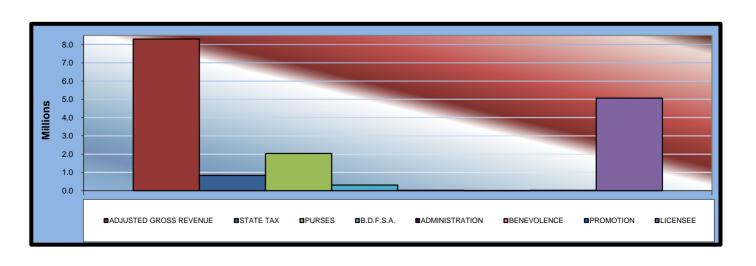
