To the County Excise Board of said County and State, Greeting:-

Pursuant to the requirements of 68 O.S. Section 3002.
- 2. And we further certify that the estimates of the several amounts necessary for current expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025 as shown under "Schedule 8" were prepared and filed with the Governing Board as of the first Monday in July 2024, that the same have been correctly entered, and that all estimates made are entered as certified by Department Heads for the respective purposes herein set out.
 We further certify that the sums requested for salaries of City/Town officers and the deputies are calculated and based upon authority of salary statutes currently effective and applicable.
- 3. We further certify that the estimated income from sources other than ad valorem tax, shown on "Schedule 4", may reasonably be expected to be collected as a revenue during the ensuing fiscal year, and is not in excess of the 90% of the amounts collected for the same sources during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024.
