THE MANGUM UTILITY AUTHORITY HAD A SEWER MAIN REPAIR THAT REQUIRED THE RENTAL OF A TRACK HOE AND THAT MONEY NEEDS TO BE BUDGETED USING THE MANGUM UTILITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND.


