Blackwell, Blackwell, Oklahoma.

- 2. Opening Ceremonies: Invocation was given by Jon Webb and the Flag Salute led by Steve Marquardt.
- 3. Special Presentations and/or Recognitions: None
- 4. Consent Agenda: All items listed are considered non-controversial and will be approved by one motion of the governing body unless a request for discussion of an item is made by a Council Member in which case the item(s) will be removed from the Consent Agenda and held for discussion and possible action on Item #5. There was discussion on select items on the requisition register. A motion was made by Tom Beliel and seconded by Steve Marquardt to approve the consent agenda. There was discussion between the council, city manager and city attorney on the COVID-19 Small Business Forgivable Loan Program. A motion was made by Tom Beliel and seconded by Steve Marquardt to approve the Small Business Forgivable Loan Program with changes recommended by council to include the change in amount to be \$1,500 for businesses deemed as non-essential businesses and \$2,500 for businesses deemed as essential businesses. - C. Consideration to Approve construction contract for Nowak Construction Co., Inc. for the sewer maintenance project-City & BMA.
