TOWN OF PORUM, OKLAHOMA BUDGET MESSAGE June 17, 2014

To the Chairman, Members of the Town Council, and the Citizens of Porum:

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The budget for the Town of Porum for the fiscal year 2014-2015 has been prepared for your consideration and approval. The proposed budget is a balanced budget prepared in accordance with the Oklahoma Municipal Budget Act in Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The budget was formulated with a conservative approach to anticipate revenues and expenditures and should allow the Town to offer a quality level of public services while continuing to improve our financial condition.

The combined total of all town funds is \$305,620. This represents an increase from last year's total of \$291,100. Sewer revenues collected by Porum Public Works are being transferred to the Town of Porum General Fund.

Funds were provided by the County of Muskogee last year to purchase needed supplies for the Porum Volunteer Fire Department. In 2014 - 2015, the Porum Volunteer Fire Department will again use these Muskogee County funds to purchase much of their equipment and supplies.

As you may be aware, the Town of Porum has been struggling to operate primarily on our city sales tax revenues. Last fiscal year, revenues exceeded our original budgeted expectations by \$31,580 due, in part, from additional police fines and forfeitures collected. This projected additional revenue is included in the 2014 - 2015 budget, as well as additional sales tax revenue expected from new retail businesses operating within the city limits.

Although the Town of Porum should continue to operate with additional sales tax revenue and the transfer of sewer income collected by Porum Public Works Authority, we must still consider our cash flow, which is currently not sufficient to balance the Town of Porum budget for FY 2014-2015. The Town budget may require a transfer of \$29,070 from Porum Public Works Authority for Fiscal Year 2014 - 2015 in order to balance.

The Town of Porum financial statements will conform to GASB-34 Oklahoma state requirements.

We are continuing to pursue opportunities to increase revenues and reduce expenses. We strive to apply for every grant available in our area and will continue to do so. The residents of Porum and the Town Council members will be furnished regular financial updates to monitor our financial progress during the fiscal year 2014 - 2015.
