Pursuant to the requirements of 68 O.S. 1991 Section 3002, we submit herewith for your consideration, the within statement of the fiscal condition of the City/Town of Woodlawn Park, State of Oklahoma, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021, together with an itemized statement of the estimated needs thereof for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022. The same have been prepared in conformity to Statute, in relation to which be it further noted that:

1. We, the members of the Governing Board of said City/Town and State, do hereby certify that the statements herein submitted show the true and correct conditions of the fiscal affairs of said City/Town for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, that said statements comprise a "full and accurate statement of the assessments, receipts and expenditures of the preceding year, made out in detail under separate heads" that said preparation was had at an official session of said Board, begun on the first Monday in July, 2021 pursuant to the provisions of 68 O.S. 1991 Section 3002.

2. And we further certify that the estimates of the several amounts necessary for current expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022 as shown under "Schedule 8" were prepared and filed with the Governing Board as of the first Monday in July 2021, that the same have been correctly entered, and that all estimates made are entered as certified by Department Heads for the respective purposes herein set out. We further certify that the sums requested for salaries of City/Town officers and the deputies are calculated and based upon authority of salary statutes currently effective and applicable.

3. We further certify that the estimated income from sources other than ad valorem tax, shown on "Schedule 4", may reasonably be expected to be collected as a revenue during the ensuing fiscal year, and is not in excess of the 90% of the amounts collected for the same sources during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021.

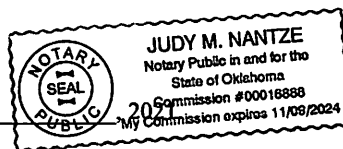

CERTIFICATE OF EXCISE BOARD
ESTIMATE OF NEEDS FOR 2021-2022

STATE OF OKLAHOMA, COUNTY OF OKLAHOMA

We, the members of the Excise Board of said County and State, do hereby certify that we have examined the foregoing estimates of proposed current expenses for the ensuing fiscal year as filed with the Governing Board of Woodlawn Park Oklahoma, and those directly under, or in contractual relationship with, the Governing Board of Woodlawn Park Oklahoma; we have ascertained from the Financial Statements submitted therewith the amount of Surplus Balances of Cash on Hand; we have considered the uncollected ad valorem taxes of the previous year or years; and we have ascertained that the probable Income estimated to be collected from all sources other than ad valorem taxation may reasonably be expected as a revenue for the ensuing fiscal year, and that the same does not exceed 90% of the actual collection from such sources for the previous fiscal year.

In so doing, we have diligently performed the duties imposed upon the Excise Board by 68 O.S. 1991 Section 3007, (1) ascertaining that the financial statements, as to statistics therein contained reflect the true fiscal condition at the close of the fiscal year, or caused the same to be corrected so to show; (2) struck from the estimate of needs so submitted any items not authorized by law and reduced to the sum authorized by law any items restricted by statute as to the amount lawfully expendable therefore; (3) supplemented such estimate, after proper publication, by an estimate of needs prepared by this Excise Board to make provision for mandatory governmental functions where the estimate submitted wholly failed or was deemed inadequate to fulfill the mandate of the Constitutions or of the Legislature; (4) computed the total means available to each fund in the manner provided; and (5) then and only thereafter. -

Accordingly, we have and do hereby appropriate the Surplus Balances of Cash on Hand, and the Revenues and Levies hereinafter set forth for each Fund to the several and specific purposes named in such estimates, by each, to the intent and purpose that CONSTITUTIONAL GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTIONS shall be first assured and provided for, and subsequently to provide for Legislative Governmental Functions insofar as to the available Surpluses, Revenues and Levies will permit; and we have provided also that the Levies are in excess of the amount appropriated to needs after deducting the surplus cash balance on hand, and Estimated Revenues other than tax, by the percentage and amount or reserve for delinquent tax as hereinafter set forth, which we have determined in the manner provided by law.

We further certify that we have examined the within statements of account and estimated needs or requirements of the Governing Board of Woodlawn Park Oklahoma, in relation to the Sinking Fund or Funds thereof, and after finding the same correct or having caused the same to be corrected pursuant to 68 O. S. 1991 Section 3009, have approved the requirements therefor to fulfill the conditions of Section 26 and 28 of Article 10, Oklahoma Constitution, and have made and certified a tax levy therefor to the extent of the excess of said total requirements over the total of items 2, 3, 6, and 12 of Exhibit "Y" (Page 2) and any other legal deduction, including a reserve of ____% for delinquent taxes.
