Pursuant to the District Attorney's request and in accordance with the requirements of **74 O.S. 2001**, **§ 212(H)**, we conducted a special audit with respect to the Town of Sasakwa, Seminole County, Oklahoma, for the period October 1, 2003 through December 17, 2003.

The objectives of our special audit primarily included, but were not limited to, possible embezzlement of monies from the General and Municipal Funds. Our findings and recommendations related to these procedures are presented in the accompanying report.

Because the above procedures do not constitute an audit conducted in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, we do not express an opinion on the account balances or financial statements of the Town of Sasakwa for the period October 1, 2003 through December 17, 2003. Further, due to the test nature and other inherent limitations of a special audit report, together with the inherent limitations of any internal control structure, there is an unavoidable risk that some material misstatements may remain undiscovered. This report relates only to the accounts and items specified above and does not extend to any financial statements of the Town taken as a whole.

This report is intended to provide information to the District Attorney, Mayor, Board of Trustees and Administration of the Town. This restriction is not intended to limit the distribution of the report, which is a matter of public record when released.

#### INTRODUCTION

The Town of Sasakwa, Oklahoma is organized under the statutory town board of trustees form of government, as outlined in **11 O.S. 2001, § 12-101**, *et seq.*, The members of the Board of Trustees and the Town Clerk/Treasurer serve as the board of Trustees for the Sasakwa Municipal Authority.

#### 11 O.S. 2001, § 12-101, et seq. states:

"The form of government provided by Sections 12-101 through 12-114 of this title shall be known as the statutory town board of trustees form of government. Towns governed under the statutory town board of trustees form shall have all the powers, functions, rights, privileges, franchises and immunities granted, or which may be granted, to towns. Such powers shall be exercised as provided by law applicable to towns under the town board of trustees form, or if the manner is not thus prescribed, then in such manner as the board of trustees may prescribe."

The Town is audited by a private, independent audit firm. Audit reports were made available for our review.

The State Auditor and Inspector conducted a special audit of the records of the Town of Sasakwa, primarily those records relating to the District Attorney's concerns. The results of the special audit are in the following report.

# CONCERNS, FINDINGS, AND RECOMMENDATIONS

# CONCERN: Possible embezzlement of monies from the General and Municipal Funds.

FINDING: The Town of Sasakwa did not maintain approved claims with supporting documentation attached for all expenditures. We examined bank statements, paid checks, and receipt printouts obtained from Wal-Mart. We noted payments to Wal-Mart, Dish Network, American Camper, and TH Rogers for items that appear to be for personal use. The Town Trustees obtained a receipt printout from Wal-Mart for all but eleven (11) of the expenditures. They stated that Dish Network or American Camper did not provide services to the Town. Furthermore, we noted that the Clerk/Treasurer purchased a hot water heater at TH Rogers for a Town resident

Based on the information, it appears the Clerk/Treasurer expended Town funds to purchase items and services for personal use totaling \$6,813.89. (See Appendix A) This amount includes Wal-Mart shopping cards totaling \$2,987.99, thirty-nine (39) DVD's, three (3) DVD players, air conditioner, skate board, toys, hot water heater, and other miscellaneous items. The purchase of items for personal use appears to be a violation of **21 O.S. 2001, § 341**.

Further, we obtained written statements from the former mayor documenting that the signatures on nine (9) of the checks written to Wal-Mart were forged.

During an interview with the Clerk/Treasurer she stated she only purchased necessary office supplies at Wal-Mart. Furthermore, she signed an affidavit stating she never purchased any toys or shopping cards with town funds; however, during a review of shopping card printouts obtained from Wal-Mart we noted the Clerk/Treasurer used shopping cards in conjunction with her EBT food stamp card to purchase food and toys. The shopping cards noted were purchased with town funds. **Title 21 O.S. 2001 § 341** states,

"Every public officer of the state or any county, city, town, or member or officer of the Legislature, and every deputy or clerk of any such officer and every other person receiving any money or other thing of value on behalf of or account of this state or any department of the government of this state or any bureau or fund created by law and in which this state or the people thereof, are directly or indirectly interested, who either:

First: Receives, directly or indirectly, any interest, profit or perquisites, arising from the use or loan of public funds in the officer's or person's hands or money to be raised through an agency for state, city, town, district, or county purposes; or

Second: Knowingly keeps any false account, or makes any false entry or erasure in any account of or relating to any moneys so received by him, on behalf of the state, city, town, district or county, or the people thereof, or in which they are interested; or

Third: Fraudulently alters, falsifies, cancels, destroys or obliterates any such account, shall, upon conviction, thereof, be deemed guilty of a felony and shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a term of not less than one (1) year nor more than twenty (20) years and, in addition thereto, the person shall be disqualified to hold office in this state, and the court shall issue an order of such forfeiture, and should appeal be taken from the judgment of the court, the defendant may, in the discretion of the court, stand suspended from such office until such cause is finally

**RECOMMENDATION:** We recommend the proper authorities review this finding to determine what action may be necessary. In addition, we recommend the Board of Trustees establish policies and procedures to assure all expenditures are approved by the Board at an open meeting, supported by itemized receipts, and document that the goods and/or services have been received.

**FINDING:** We noted that the Clerk/Treasurer issued, to herself, thirty-three (33) checks totaling \$6,486.00 in addition to her salary. (See Appendix B) These checks were signed by the Clerk/Treasurer and the former or acting mayor. We obtained documentation from the former mayor stating that signatures on seven (7) of the checks were forged. It appears these payments are a violation of **21 O.S. 2001, § 341**, previously cited.

During an interview with the Clerk/Treasurer she stated she was paid for services rendered such as painting and work performed on the water lines. We were unable to obtain documentation to confirm this statement.

**RECOMMENDATION:** We recommend the proper authorities review this finding to determine what action may be necessary. In addition, we recommend the Board of Trustees establish policies and procedures to provide greater oversight of checks issued and expenditure of funds.

**FINDING:** We noted payments totaling \$4,127.00 were made to the acting mayor for work performed for the Town. (See Appendix C) The acting mayor stated that he was paid to work on the water lines and mow town property. We found no documentation that the Board approved hiring the acting mayor to perform these jobs. Also, there was no contract or supporting documentation for the services provided. The payments to the trustee appears to be a violation of **11 O.S. 2001, § 8-113** 

#### Title 11 O.S. 2001 § 8-113 states,

"Except as otherwise provided by this section, no municipal officer or employee, or any business in which the officer, employee, or spouse of the officer or employee has a proprietary interest, shall engage in:

1. Selling, buying, or leasing property, real or personal, to or from the municipality;

2. Contracting with the municipality; or

3. Buying or bartering for or otherwise engaging in any manner in the acquisition of any bonds, warrants, or other evidence of indebtedness of the municipality."

**RECOMMENDATION:** We recommend the proper authorities review this finding to determine what action may be necessary. In addition, we recommend the Town not contract or pay members of the Board of Trustees for services provided other than duties authorized by State statute.
