

Motion made by Kachel that the apportionment by the Excise Board of Tulsa County of the millage to the various municipalities of Tulsa County as provided by the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma, as amended, be apportioned for the year 2018-2019, in accordance with the following Resolution, to-wit:

RESOLUTION

That the County Levy for all purposes other than Sinking Fund and Millage authorized by the Constitution, as amended, shall be 10.3 mills.

In instances involving Cities and Incorporated Towns and School Districts having a net valuation in excess of Fifty Million Dollars, the apportionment, other than Sinking Fund, shall be: To such Cities and Incorporated Towns not to exceed 0 mills, and to such School Districts the millage authorized by the Constitution, as amended, and by the vote of the people of such School Districts.

In instances involving Cities and Incorporated Towns and School Districts having a net valuation of less than Fifty Million Dollars, the apportionment, other than Sinking Fund, shall be: To such Cities and Incorporated Towns not to exceed 0 mills, and to such School Districts the millage authorized by the Constitution, as amended, and by the vote of the people of such School Districts.

In instances of School Districts having a net valuation of less than Six Million Dollars and not involving Cities and Incorporated Towns located within the County of Tulsa; the apportionment of such School Districts, other than Sinking Fund, shall be: Not to exceed 0 mills in addition to the millage authorized by the Constitution, as amended, and by the vote of the people of such School Districts.
