Background Information

The City of Tulsa, Tulsa Police Department (TPD), Tulsa Fire Department (TFD), Family & Children's Services, Inc. and Mental Health Association in Tulsa, Inc. have received a grant award from the Tulsa Area United Way Collaboration Grant 2018 program. The TPD (\$28,622.00) and TFD (\$34,546.00) portion of this award totals \$63,168.00. Family & Children's Services, Inc. is the lead agency. This grant will provide partial funding for continuation of the program to operate a mobile co-responder unit, Community Response Team (CRT), two days a week within the City of Tulsa. The goal of the program is to save lives by providing the most effective responses to 911 callers in mental health crisis through an integrated, multidisciplinary mobile approach. As part of the CRT project staffing, TFD agrees to provide a paramedic and the necessary medical and vehicle equipment and TPD agrees to provide a law enforcement officer. Grant funding will provide resources toward: 1) overtime (\$57,244.00); 2) vehicle operating expenses (\$5,564.00); and 3) uniforms (\$360.00). An In-Kind match by the City of Tulsa is required for: 1) overtime (\$54,850.00); and 2) vehicle expense (\$9,973.00).



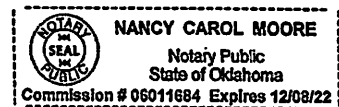

Background Information

The City of Tulsa, Tulsa Police Department (TPD) has received a grant (#19211) from the District Attorney's Council 2018 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) program totaling \$141,627.00 to create and foster safer neighborhoods through a sustained reduction in violent crime, including addressing criminal gangs and the felonious possession and use of firearms. This program provides critical funding, resources, and training for law enforcement, prosecutors, and their PSN teams to combat violent crime and make their communities safer through a comprehensive approach to public safety. The funds will be used for 2 projects;

1. Route 66 Motel Corridor Enforcement (\$70,813.50) - Officers of the TPD - Mingo Valley Division will conduct enforcement and crime prevention activities around hotels and motels with unusually high calls for police service to increase the feelings of safety and improve quality of life for citizens living and working in the area.
2. Violent and Sexual Predator Project (\$70,813.50) - Funding will assist TPD in locating and arresting unregistered sex offenders and violent offenders within the City of Tulsa.

There is no match required for this grant.
