Background Information

The City of Tulsa, Mayor's Office, Community Development and Policy section has received a grant award totaling \$7,500.00 from the Partnership for a New American Economy Research Fund, Gateways for Growth Challenge program and \$7,500.00 in matching funds from the Tulsa Community Foundation through an award from the Charles and Lynn Schusterman Family Foundation. The grant is a competitive opportunity for local communities to receive tailored research, direct technical assistance, and/or matching grants from new American Economy and Welcoming America in support of the development of multi-sector plans for welcoming and integrating immigrants into local communities. Grants funds totaling \$15,000.00 will provide resources toward: 1) Translation services (\$2,000.00); 2) communications services to include graphic design, photography (\$3,000.00); and 3) expenses related to organizing a conference, including event space, meals, and event materials (\$10,000.00).



Background Information

The City of Tulsa, Mayor's Office has received a grant award totaling \$304,000.00 from the Anne and Henry Zarrow Foundation via the Tulsa Community Foundation. The grant funds the first two years of a new City of Tulsa employee position, the Director of Housing Policy, which will be under the direction of the Chief of Economic Development and will be responsible for researching and addressing housing shortcomings in Tulsa, as well as coordinating City use of federal and City housing funds and working with the Tulsa Housing Authority and other community partners. Grant funds totaling \$304,000.00 will provide resources for: 1) Salary and benefits for the position for two years (\$284,000.00); and 2) professional search firm services for the position (\$20,000.00).

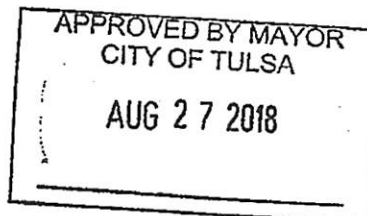



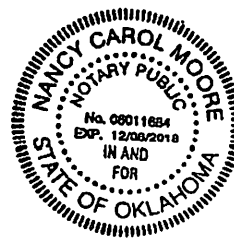

The City of Tulsa has received a Cities of Service - Engaged Cities Grant Award totaling \$70,000.00. 

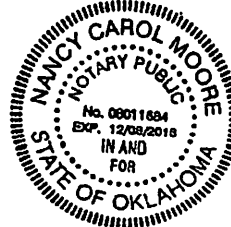

Background Information

The City of Tulsa, Tulsa Police Department (TPD) has received a grant (2017-DJ-BX-0831) award in the amount of \$333,578.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice. Of this amount, TPD will receive \$314,011.00, and Tulsa County will receive \$19,567.00. The City will "pass through" funds to Tulsa County through a Memorandum of Understanding. The Tulsa Police Department will use their portion of funding for law enforcement projects to include: 1) Overtime for Sex Offender Program and directed patrols - \$95,000.00, 2) Miscellaneous equipment to include: less lethal munitions, physical fitness equipment, Special Response Team equipment and supplies - \$50,511.00, 3) Equipment and supplies for Tulsa Police Reserve Program cadets - \$50,000.00, 4) Resources toward Records and Case Management System - \$100,000.00; and 5) Inventory System software upgrade and data migration - \$18,500.00.

This action will appropriate \$315,099.00 to the FEMA 18 - Tupelo Creek Flood Control Project within the FEMA Grants Fund (Sub-Fund No. 2604). This funding will serve as the 68% award from the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program with the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management (FEMA-42560018-OK) >

The City was awarded a Hazard Mitigation Grant from FEMA and to be administered locally through the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management (OEM). The City will manage the project. OEM will reimburse the City 68% (\$315,099.00) of the City's eligible expenditures which shall be appropriated through this budget action.
