Background Information

This budget amendment will appropriate revenue of \$261,373.73 from the Office of the District Attorney, Revolving Drug Fund, Tulsa County, OK as follows: 1) Tulsa Police Dept. Special Investigations Division (SID) - Tulsa County Drug Fund portion of annual lease for SID building - \$78,816.00; 2) various licensing, annual maintenance, support fees and equipment for investigative software applications related to intelligence gathering, communications, identifying information database, surveillance and mobile forensic data extraction - \$30,381.25; 3) office equipment for additional personnel and replacement of certain existing office equipment - \$22,000.00; 4) estimated training for FY20 for SID staff requiring special training at onset of their tenure as well as ongoing training; training will be subject to approval by the Chief of Police and Mayor of the City of Tulsa - \$60,000.00; 5) wireless communications, currently paid by Tulsa County from DA Drug Fund resources; this change is shifting the administrative work of paying the invoices to the City of Tulsa and resources will still be provided by this source - \$70,176.48.

The Tulsa Police Department (TPD) Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) program trains nurses throughout the state of Oklahoma on how to collect evidence for rape kits and violent offenses. This program generates fee for service revenue as well as donations which are to be used for SANE education. This budget amendment will also appropriate revenue of this type totaling \$1,500.00 for the TPD SANE nurse to attend educational courses and to provide materials and supplies for training courses held throughout the year for other SANE nurses.

Policy Statement

Background Information

This action will recognize reimbursements of \$800,000.00 as defined in contract 134441 between the City of Tulsa and Tulsa Zoo Management Inc (TZMI); and appropriate \$800,000.00 to the Helmerich Playground Project (19340000Z) within the 2014 Sales Tax Fund (Fund 405).

This action will recognize TZMI's contribution \$800,000 to the Helmerich Playground project being constructed at the Tulsa Zoo. The total estimated cost of the playground is \$1,650,000.00. Per the agreement, the City will fund the first \$850,000 of project expenses; while TZMI will fund the remaining \$800,000. TZMI may incur additional expenses beyond the construction contract at it's discretion. The City will administer the construction contract, and after completing the first \$850,000 in expenses will process partial payment requests from contractor submitting periodic invoices with documentation to TZMI for reimbursement up to the TZMI Capped amount.
