

Background Information

Start of Year Budget Amendment and Council Transfer - FY25

General Fund (100), EMSA Utility Fund (121), Public Safety Tax Fund (150), Short Term Capital Fund (477), Stormwater Enterprise Fund (560), Water Operating Fund (740), Sewer Operating Fund (750)

Council Transfer - General Fund: This action will:

* Transfer \$20,000.00 between departments within the General Fund to reduce appropriations for QR Code tours in the Managed Entities Department and increase appropriations in the Department of City Experience for Main Street programs.

Budget Amendment - Multiple Funds: This action will:

- * Reduce unnecessary appropriations totaling \$1,570,678.00 of re-appropriated FY24 funds across multiple Funds and Departments; as FY24 funds were able to be encumbered prior to beginning FY25. Depts 21, 22, 32, and 33. Funds 121, 477, 560, 740, and 750.
- * Reappropriate FY24 funds totaling \$185,022.00 within the Fire Department in the Public Safety Tax Fund. Funds were unable to be encumbered for Fire equipment needs prior to beginning FY25.

Summation of the Requested Action

Please request that the Mayor and Council approve the attached Budget Amendment Ordinance, BA100123. This Amendment includes a budget increase of \$185,022.00, a decrease of \$1,570,678.00 and a transfer of \$20,000.00.



Policy Statement

Background Information

This action will appropriate a total of \$430,000.00, recognized from revenue received through a Tourism Improvement District Special Assessment Tax, awarded to the Managed Entities Economic and Development Department within the TOURISM IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 1 FUND [FUND 143].

In November of 2018, the City of Tulsa created the Tourism Improvement District No. 1. This district is comprised of properties within the City on which is located a hotel or motel, having 110 or more rooms available for occupancy. Pursuant to resolution #19938, a special tax assessment of 3 percent of gross proceeds derived from the occupancy of a room in a hotel or motel subject to the assessment was levied. The first 2 percent of all assessments collected are retained by the City to pay expenses incurred in the performance its obligations under the District Plan. The remaining 98 percent is retained for the general purpose of soliciting marketing services leading to increased occupancy and room rates for all assessed properties within the district.



Policy Statement

Background Information

This action will appropriate a total of \$5,250,000.00, to the PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT within the 2001 SALES TAX FUND [FUND 401], the 2006 SPECIAL EXTENDED SALES TAX FUND [FUND 402], the 2008 FIX OUR STREETS FUND [FUND 404], and the 2014 IMPROVE OUR TULSA 1 FUND [FUND 405].

This budget action will appropriate a total of \$5,250,000.00 for the rehabilitation and conversion of 1st Street, 2nd Street and 4th Street from one-way streets to two-way streets as listed below.

1st Street - mill and overlay from Denver to Elgin and conversion from Denver to Greenwood

2nd Street - conversion from Denver to Greenwood

4th Street - rehabilitation from Detroit to US-75 and conversion from Denver to Detroit

The total projected cost of this project is \$11,100,000. In addition to this budget action, a council transfer (CT42828) will transfer and appropriate an additional \$1,200,000.00. The remaining project cost of \$4,650,000 is to be included in a future general obligation bond issuance within the Improve Our Tulsa 2 program.
