CITY OF OWASSO, OKLAHOMA ORDINANCE 1165

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING TO THE PUBLIC A ROADWAY EASEMENT LOCATED IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER (NW1/4) OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE1/4) OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE1/4) OF SECTION THIRTY-ONE (31), T21N, R14E, OF THE I.B.&M., TULSA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, OWASSO, OKLAHOMA, REFERRING FILED PLAT NUMBER 4204 (BOOK 4600, PAGE 1025)

WHEREAS, the City of Owasso, Oklahoma, has deemed it necessary and expedient to close to the public use, a portion of a roadway easement herein attached as Exhibit "A"; and, WHEREAS, the City of Owasso retains the absolute right to reopen the same without expense to the municipality, and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OWASSO, OKLAHOMA, THAT TO WIT:

SECTION 1:
ALL THAT PART OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER (NW1/4) OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE1/4) OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE1/4) OF SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 21 NORTH, RANGE 14 EAST OF THE INDIAN BASE AND MERIDIAN, CITY OF OWASSO, TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING AT A 3/8" IRON BAR MARKING THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 2, BLOCK 2 OF OWASSO BUSINESS PARK PLAT # 4204, INSTRUMENT # 42413; THENCE S88°29'48"W, 5.31 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE CONTINUING S88°29'48"W, 7.56 FEET TO A MAG NAIL MARKING THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE TRACT; THENCE

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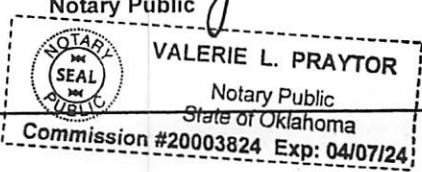
