On June 8, 2021, the Morgans Corner Fire District board held a public meeting to discuss and approve the proposed budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022. The board approved transferring \$50,000 to the building fund/savings account for the future purchase and building of a new fire station. Also approved by the board was \$10,000 to place hydrants in our district. The hydrants are already property of the fire district so the expense will be for installation. Lastly, the board approved an estimated expense of a truck payment for the purchase of a vehicle to be outfitted as a grass truck to replace an existing grass truck.
