With the increase in federal funding for COVID-19 and from the Infrastructure Investment and Job Act (IIJA), both federal awarding agencies and pass-through entities are looking to Single Audits more than ever as an important tool in providing transparency for federal programs. New funding and requirements are making Single Audits more complex than ever to perform. For 2021, over 45K Single Audits were completed and submitted to the Federal Audit Clearinghouse. Learning how to conduct, report, and use Single Audits are

valuable skills to have and maintain and this course will aid you in strengthening your Single Audit skills!
