Independent Accountant's Report on Applying Agreed-Upon Procedures

To the Specified Users of the Report:

Town Council, Town of Bray Bray, Oklahoma

Oklahoma Office of State Auditor and Inspector Oklahoma City, Oklahoma

We have compiled the accompanying Summary of Changes in Fund Balances-Cash Basis of the Town of Bray, Oklahoma as of June 30, 2018, the related Budgetary Comparison Schedule of the General Fund-Cash Basis for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2018, and related Grant Schedule in accordance with Statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The financial statements have been prepared in a format and basis of accounting prescribed by Oklahoma Statutes that demonstrates compliance with the cash basis and budget laws of the State of Oklahoma. This is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles.

A compilation is limited to presenting information in the form of financial statements prescribed by Oklahoma Statutes that is the representation of the management. We have not audited or reviewed the accompanying financial statements and accordingly, do not express an opinion or any other form of assurance on them.

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the accompanying statements in accordance with their comprehensive basis of accounting. Management is also responsible for the designing, implementing, and maintaining internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements.

Our responsibility is to conduct the compilation in accordance with Statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The objective of a compilation is to assist management in presenting financial information in the form of financial statements without undertaking to obtain or provide any assurance that there are no material modifications that should be made to the financial statements.

Management has elected to omit substantially all of the disclosures ordinarily included in financial statements prepared on the cash basis of accounting. If the omitted disclosures were included in the financial statements, they might influence the user's conclusions about the Town's assets, liabilities, equity, revenues and expenses. Accordingly, these financial statements are not designed for those who are not informed about such matters.

Additionally, we have performed the procedures enumerated below which were agreed to by the specified users of the report, as identified above, and as defined within the applicable state laws of the State of Oklahoma solely to assist the Town in meeting its financial accountability requirements as prescribed by Oklahoma Statutes §11-17 (105-107) and §60-180.1-.3 and evaluating compliance with specified legal or contractual requirements for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2018. Management of the Town of Bray is responsible for the Town's financial accountability and its compliance with those legal and contractual requirements. This agree-upon procedures engagement was conducted in accordance with the attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of those parties specified in this report. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

Procedures and Findings

As to the **Town of Bray** as of and for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2018:

1. Procedures Performed: From the Town's trial balances, we prepared a summary of changes in fund balances for each major fund and compared the schedule results to the statutory prohibition of creating fund balance deficits to report any noted instances of noncompliance.

Findings: We found no instances of noncompliance.

2. Procedures Performed: From the Town's trial balances, we prepared a budget and actual financial schedule for the General Fund and compared the actual expenditures and encumbrances reported to the authorized appropriations to report any noted instances of noncompliance with appropriation limitations.

Findings: The Town was over budget in only one category, personnel services.

3. Procedures Performed: We agreed the Town's material bank account balances to bank statements, and traced the timely clearance of significant reconciling items to report any significant or unusual instances of reconciling items that have not cleared.

Findings: We found no instances of any significant or unusual reconciling items.

4. Procedures Performed: We compared the Town's uninsured deposits to fair value of pledged collateral to report any amounts of uninsured and uncollateralized deposits.

Findings: We found no uninsured or uncollateralized deposits.

5. Procedures Performed: We compared use of material-restricted revenues and resources to their restrictions to report any noted instances of noncompliance.

Findings: We found no instances of noncompliance.

6. Procedures Performed: We compared the accounting for the Town's activities by fund to the legal and contractual requirements for separate funds to report any noted instances of noncompliance.

Findings: We found no instances of noncompliance.

7. Procedures Performed: We compared the Town's account balances in reserve accounts to contractually required balances and debt service coverage requirements of bond indentures to the actual coverage to report any noted instances of noncompliance.

Findings: We found no instances of noncompliance.

As to the **Town of Bray Grant Programs**, as of and for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2018:

1. Procedures Performed: From the Town's trial balances, we prepared a schedule of grant activity for each grant and compared the receipts and disbursements to grant agreements and supporting information to report any noted instances of noncompliance with the grant agreement(s).

Findings: We found no instances of noncompliance.
