1. General support

From State (code C3Ø) — Enter amount received from alcoholic beverage tax county distribution.

2. Streets and highways (codes C46, D46, and B46)

Enter receipts from commercial vehicle tags, gasoline tax, bus mileage tax, registration tags.

3. Health or hospitals (codes C42, D42, and B42)

In the appropriate column, list any intergovernmental revenues received for operation of a hospital, health facility, or health department, (grants, not loans) or funds received from other government jurisdictions for health services or facilities operated by your government.

4. Grants received for utilities (codes C91 to B91)

- Grants received for mass transit and/or bus systems (codes C94 to B94)
- 9. All other (From State —code C-89; From Federal Government code B89)

Include in the appropriate box, receipts from various payments such

- Park and recreation (BOR or HUD)
- · Community development and urban renewal
- · Civic defense
- · Water and sewer facilities
- Manpower planning and utilization

Part 1B - OTHER REVENUE

3. Special assessment funds

Include -

- All transactions of special assessment funds established to finance streets, sidewalks, or other local improvements within the city.
- Assessments collected from property owners at part IB, item 3.
- Expenditure from improvements at part II. Report as capital outlay.
- Interest paid on special assessment obligations at part II,
- Transactions of special assessment bonds at part V.
- Cash and security holdings of special assessment funds at part VI.

Part IV — SALARIES, WAGES, AND FORCE ACCOUNT

Report salaries and wages for all employees full- and part-time. Include salaries paid for employees of any utility owned and operated by your government. Report salaries in gross amounts before deductions for income taxes, Social Security, or retirement coverage.

Part V — DEBT OUTSTANDING, ISSUED, AND RETIRED

Also include industrial revenue or pollution control bonds, if issued by your city or town.
