Report revenue from city-imposed sales tax only. This tax is collected by the State and paid back to the city minus a small percentage withheld by the State for handling expenses. Be sure to enter only the amount of the check received from the State.

b. Franchise fee or tax, public utilities (code T15)

Enter here any franchise tax collected from a private utility to operate within the city such as gas, electric, telephone, cable TV, etc.

d. Other - Specify any sales tax not mentioned above.

3. Licenses, permits, and other taxes

a. Licenses, permits, and taxes (code T28)

Enter here ticenses and inspection charges on occupation and business.

b. Report only licenses & permits not included in 3a. (code T29)
