Include in the appropriate box, receipts from various payments such as

Part IB — OTHER REVENUE

3. Special assessment funds Include

- · All transactions of special assessment funds established to finance streets, sidewalks, or other local improvements within the city.
- Assessments collected from property owners at part IB. item 3.
- · Expenditure from improvements at part II. Report as capital outlay.
- · Interest paid on special assessment obligations as part II, Item 19e. • Transactions of special assessment bonds at part V.

Part IV - SALARIES, WAGES, AND FORCE ACCT.

Report salaries and wages for all employees full- and part-time. Include salaries paid for employees of any utility owned and operated by your government. Report salaries in gross amounts before deductions for income taxes, Social Security, or retirement coverage.

Part V — DEBT OUTSTANDING, ISSUED & RETIRED

Also include industrial revenue or pollution control bonds, if issued by your city or town.
