#### 3. Special assessment funds Include —

- All transactions of special assessment funds established to finance streets, sidewalks, or other local improvements within the city.
- Assessments collected from property owners at part IB, item 3
- Expenditure from improvements at part II. Report as capital outlay.
- Interest paid on special assessment obligations as part II, Item 19e.
- Transactions of special assessment bonds at part V.
- Cash and security holdings of special assessment funds at part VI.

## ${\bf Part~IV-SALARIES, WAGES, AND~FORCE~ACCT.}$

Report salaries and wages for all employees full- and part-time. Include salaries paid for employees of any utility owned and operated by your government. Report salaries in gross amounts before deductions for income taxes, Social Security, or retirement coverage.

# ${\bf Part~V-DEBT~OUTSTANDING,~ISSUED~\&~RETIRED}$

Also include industrial revenue or pollution control bonds, if issued by your city or town.
