## **COVERAGE OF THIS REPORT**

The financial reporting entity for which information is to be presented should comply with generally accepted accounting principles for governments. Current authoritative guidance is provided in GASB Codification Section 2100 and/or GASB Statement No. 14. These statements prescribe that the financial reporting entity should consist of the primary government or oversight unit and all blended and discreetly presently component units.

Oklahoma Statutes, Section 17-105.1 of Title 11 require that municipalities include information relating to all of its duly constituted authorities. Copies of this form may be distributed to component units for their completion. Forms completed by component units should not be filed separately but should be returned to the appopriate municipality for inclusion in the report filed for the financial reporting entity.
