The financial statements have been prepared on a prescribed basis of accounting that demonstrates compliance with the cash basis and budget laws of the State of Oklahoma, which is a basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles.

My compilation was limited to presenting, in the form prescribed by the Oklahoma State Auditor and Inspector, information that is the representation of management. I have not audited or reviewed the financial statements referred to above and accordingly do not express an opinion or any other form of assurance on them.

These financial statements are presented in accordance with the requirements of the Oklahoma State Auditor and Inspector, which differ from generally accepted accounting principles. Management has elected to omit all of the disclosures ordinarily included in financial statement. If the omitted disclosures were included in the financial statements, they might influence of the user's conclusions about the Town of Carrier's assets, liabilities, revenues and expenses. Accordingly, these financial statements are not designed for those who are not informed about such matter.
