COVERAGE OF THIS REPORT

The financial reporting entity for which information is to be presented should comply with generally accepted accounting principles for governments. Current authoritative guidance is provided in GASB Codification Section 2100 and/or GASB Statement No. 14. Such component units would include special districts, hospitals, boards, trusts, and authorities meeting the inclusion criteria of the statements reference above.

Part V - DEBT OUTSTANDING, ISSUED & RETIRED

Also include industrial revenue or pollution control bonds, if issued by your city or town.
